- The E-Receipt project develop a system that allows the end-user to conveniently manage their receipts and associated documents, such as warranty statements and product manuals, in one web-site. For merchants, it makes it possible to reduce the problems and costs associated with paper receipt and, as a result, improve the quality of customer service. Also, customers will be able to direct receipts directly to their accounting systems. The use of e-receipt is voluntary for both businesses and end-users.

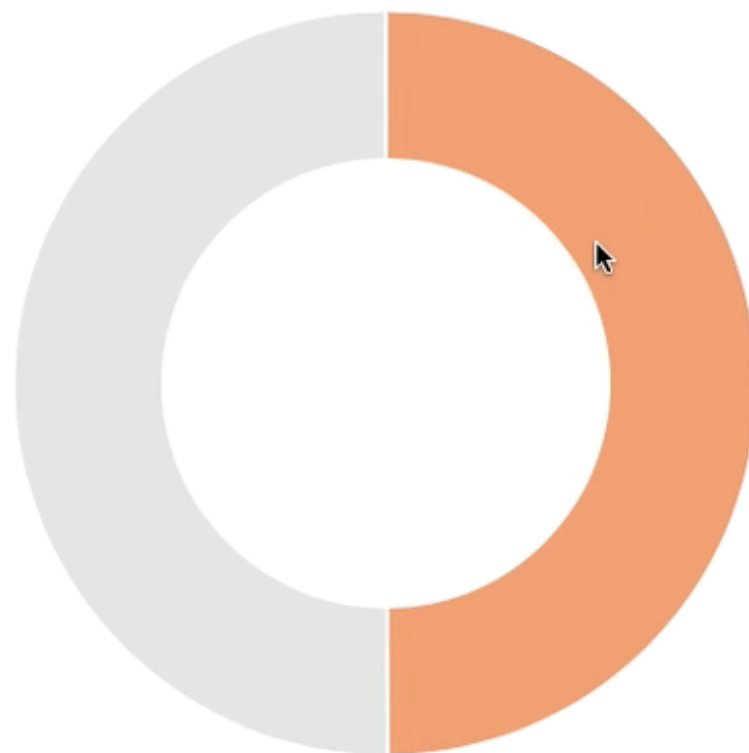

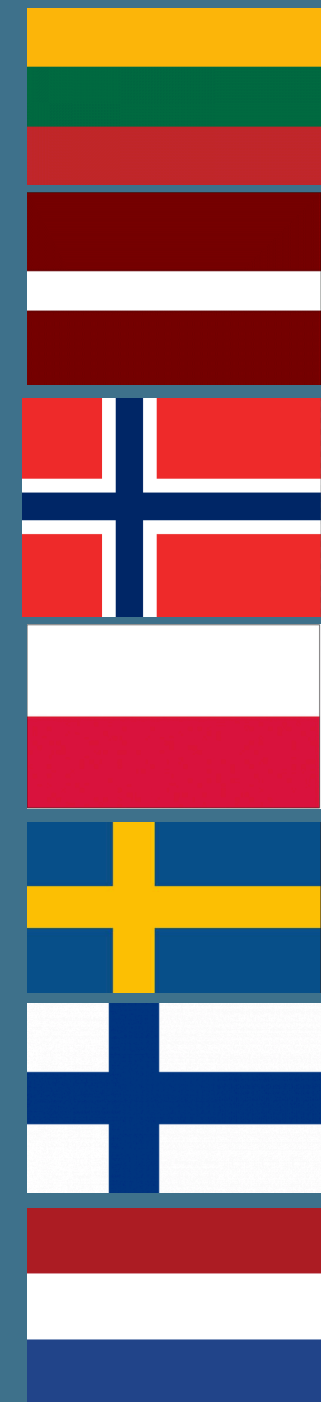
